



### **SALT (SPAIN) – April 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup>**

Thanks to the Erasmus + project linked to our high school, a trip to Salt has been organized during the first week of the spring holidays (April 18<sup>th</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup>). Salt is a small town next to Girona.

This trip about contemporary dance concerned 5 students + Mrs Ribeiro (Dean) and Mrs Arnaudo-Bernard (teacher). Just as in Nuremberg in December 2015, all students from the project took part in different workshops, helped by Spanish students and teachers.

Some visit moments allowed us to see Salt, Girona and Barcelona. Teachers also visited the movie museum in Girona. Everybody was here to attend the show inside Salt's theater (Dance, songs, drama) that was in English by the Salvador Espriu Institute students (Salt high school taking part in the project). The teachers could discover the Spanish school system and the part of learning arts. As a matter of fact this Institute welcomes an important part of students that come from disadvantaged areas and Arts are really important for integration.

At the end of the week the students showed the strength of their involvement during a dance show that was really moving. This night was also the opportunity to taste Catalan specialties among a buffet cooked by the families. Also we were invited to a casteller rehearsal to discover and participate. The last day was about visiting the Empuries, then Banyoles (except for the lake) and all the participants could discover San Jordi and its beautiful traditions.

Take note, that, as in Nuremberg last time, our students really played the game of exchange and sharing. They even took initiatives to create links between all the participants.
